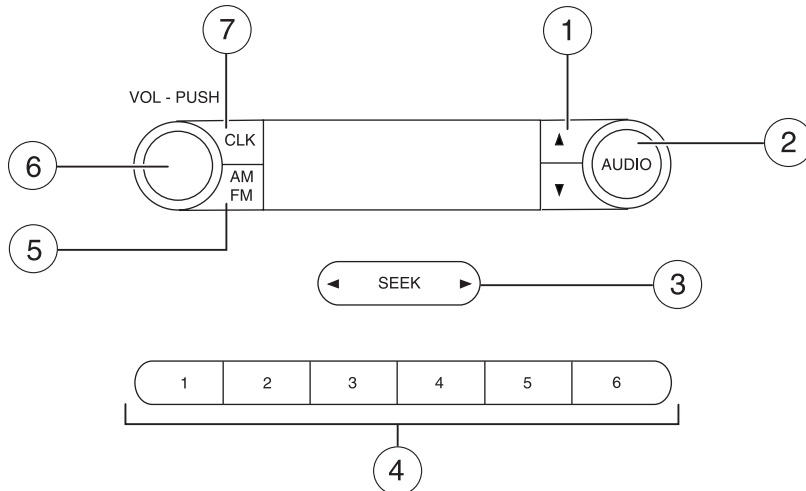

AUDIO SYSTEMS

AM/FM Stereo System (if equipped)



1. **▲ / ▼ Tune:** Press to manually go up or down the radio frequency. Also use in menu mode to select various settings.



2. **Audio:** Press to access select various settings.



Treble: Press to adjust the treble setting. Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK, SEEK ▶ .

Bass: Press to adjust the bass setting. Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK, SEEK ▶ .

Balance: Press to adjust the audio between the left and right speakers. Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK, SEEK ▶ .

Fade: Press to adjust the audio between the front and rear speakers. Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK, SEEK ▶ .

Setting the clock: Press until HR or Mn is displayed.

Press ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to adjust the hours/minutes.

3. **Seek:** Press to access the next/previous strong station.



4. **Memory presets:** To set a station: Select frequency band AM/FM; tune to a station, press and hold a preset button until sound returns.



5. **AM/FM:** Press to select AM/FM frequency band.



6. **ON/OFF/Volume:** Press to turn ON/OFF. Turn to increase/decrease volume.

If the volume is set above a certain level and the ignition is turned off, the volume will come back on at a “nominal” listening level when the ignition switch is turned back on.

7. **CLK (Clock):** Press CLK to toggle between displaying the radio frequency and the clock setting.



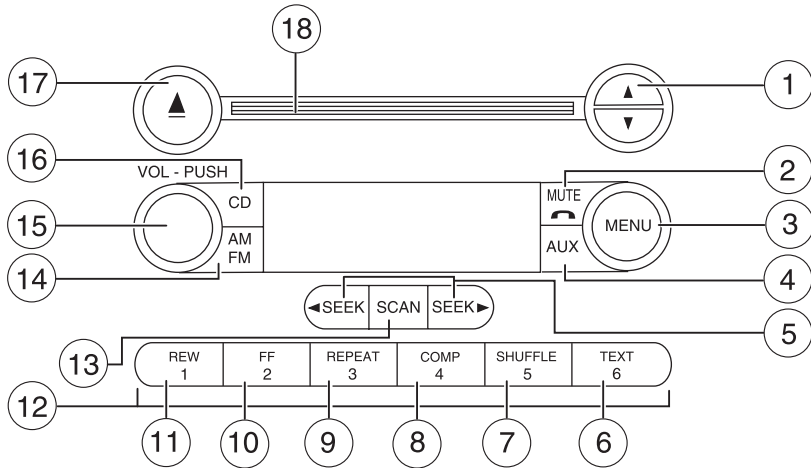
To set the clock: Press and hold

CLK until the hours begin to flash. Press ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to manually increase/decrease the hours.

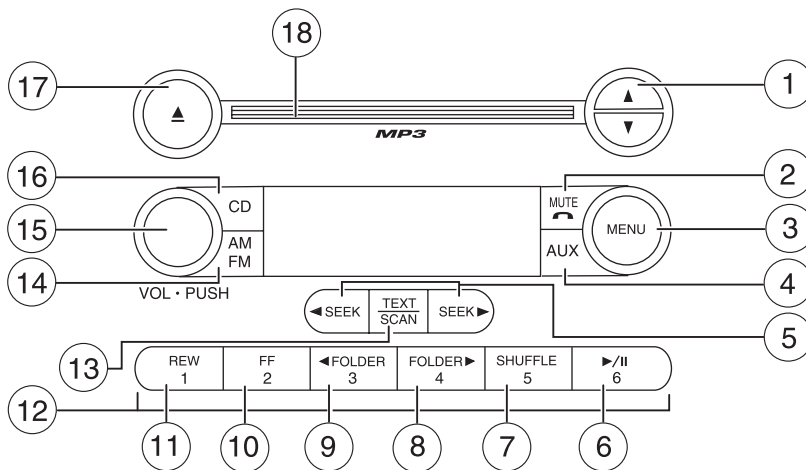
Press CLK again to set the minutes using ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to manually increase/decrease the minutes. Allow 10 seconds to pass to confirm that time set. *Not available on some models.*

1. **▲ / ▼ Tune:** In radio mode, press to manually go up (▲) or down (▼) the radio frequency.



In menu mode, use to select various settings.

In Satellite Radio mode (if equipped), press ▲ / ▼ to enter TEXT MODE and scroll through the current song title, artist, channel category and Sirius Long Channel Name. *Not available on some models.*

In TEXT MODE, sometimes the display text requires additional text to be displayed. When the ">" indicator is active press SEEK ► to view the additional display text. When the "<" indicator is active press ◀ SEEK to view to the previous display text.

In CATEGORY MODE, press ▲ / ▼ to scroll through the list of available Sirius channel Categories (Pop, Rock, News, etc.). Refer to *Category Mode* under *Menu* for further information.

Satellite radio is available only in the continental United States with a valid SIRIUS radio subscription.

2. **Phone/mute:** Press to mute the playing media. Press again to return to the playing media.



3. **Menu:** Press to toggle through the following modes:



CATEGORY (Satellite Radio if equipped): Press MENU until the currently active category appears in the display (CATEGORY MODE). In CATEGORY MODE, press ▲ / ▼ to scroll through the list of available Sirius channel Categories (Pop, Rock, News, etc.) Press ◀ SEEK ► or SCAN to select the category. After a category is selected, press SEEK to search for that specific category of channels only (i.e. ROCK). To select a different category, press MENU until the category appears in the display. Press ▲ / ▼ to select a different category. You may also select CATEGORY ALL to seek all available Sirius categories and channels. *Satellite radio is available only in the continental United States with a valid SIRIUS radio subscription.*

TREB (Treble): Press MENU until TREBLE appears in the display. Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ► to adjust the treble levels.

BASS: Press MENU until BASS appears in the display. Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to adjust the bass levels.

BAL (Balance): Press MENU until BAL appears in the display. Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to adjust the audio between the left and right speakers.

FADE: Press MENU until FADE appears in the display. Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to adjust the audio between the front and rear speakers.

COMPRESS (Compression): In CD mode, brings soft and loud CD passages together for a more consistent listening level.

Track/Folder Mode: Available only on MP3 discs in CD mode. In Track Mode, pressing ◀ SEEK ▶ will scroll through all tracks on the disc. In Folder mode, pressing ◀ SEEK ▶ will scroll only through tracks within the selected folder.

SPEEDVOL (Speed sensitive volume): Radio volume automatically changes slightly with vehicle speed to compensate for road and wind noise. Press MENU until SPEEDVOL appears in the display.

Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to adjust the levels. The recommended level is 1–3. Level 0 turns the Speed Sensitive Volume off and level 7 is the maximum setting.

AUTOSET: Allows you to set the strongest local radio stations without losing your original manually set preset stations for AM/FM1/FM2.

Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to turn on/off.

When the six strongest stations are filled, the station stored in preset 1 will begin playing. If there are less than six strong stations, the system will store the last one in the remaining presets.

CLOCK (Setting the clock): Press MENU until SELECT HOUR or SELECT MINS is displayed. Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK, SEEK ▶ to adjust the hours/minutes.

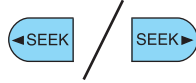
4. **Aux:** Press repeatedly to cycle through FES/DVD (if equipped), and SAT1, SAT2 and SAT3 modes (Satellite Radio if equipped). If no auxiliary sources are available, NO AUX AUDIO will be displayed.

5. **Seek:** In radio mode, press ◀ / ▶ to access the previous/next strong station.



In CD mode, press ◀ / ▶ to access the previous/next CD track.

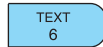
In Satellite Radio mode (if equipped), press ◀ SEEK ▶ to seek to the previous/next channel. If a specific category is selected, (Jazz, Rock, News, etc.), press ◀ SEEK ▶ to seek to the previous/next channel in the selected category. Press and hold ◀ SEEK ▶ to fast seek through the previous /next channels.

In TEXT MODE, press ◀ SEEK ▶ to view the previous/additional display text.

In CATEGORY MODE, press ◀ SEEK ▶ to select a category.

6. **Text:** This control is not operational.



Play/Pause: This control is operational in CD mode. When a CD is playing, press to pause or play the current CD. The CD status will display in the radio display.



7. **Shuffle:** Press to play tracks in random order on the current CD.



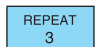
8. **Comp (Compression):** Press in CD mode to bring soft and loud CD passages together for a more consistent listening level.



FOLDER: Press to access next folder on MP3 discs, if folders are available.



9. **Repeat:** Press to repeat the current CD track.

FOLDER: press to access the previous folder on MP3 discs, if folders are available.



10. **Fast forward:** Press to manually advance in a CD track.



11. **Rewind:** Press to manually reverse in a CD track.



12. **Memory presets:** To set a station: Select frequency band AM/FM1/FM2; tune to a station, press and hold a preset control until sound returns. You may store up to six stations in each frequency band for a total of 18.



In Satellite Radio mode (if equipped), there are 18 available presets, six each for SAT1, SAT2 and SAT3. To save satellite channels in your memory presets, tune to the desired channel then press and hold a preset control until sound returns.

TEXT/SCAN: In radio and CD/MP3 mode, press and hold for a brief sampling of radio stations or CD tracks. Press again to stop.



In CD/MP3 mode, press and release to display track title, artist name, and disc title and file name (if available).

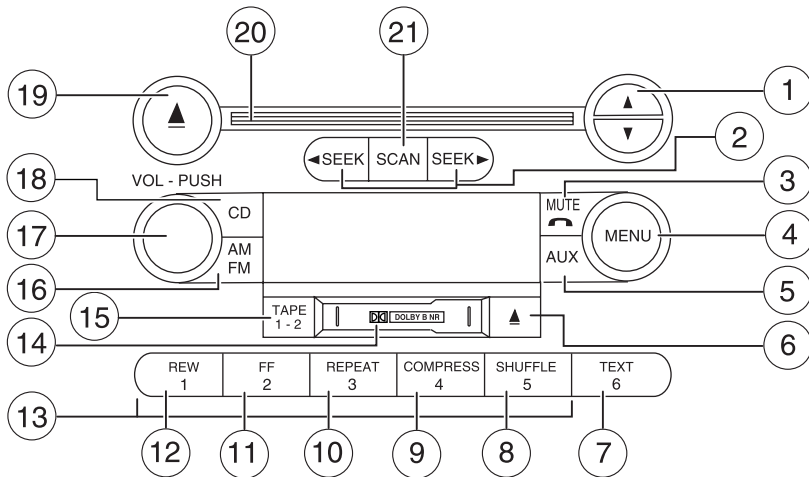

AM/FM Single CD/Cassette/Satellite Compatible Sound System (if equipped)



1. **▲ / ▼ Tune:** In radio mode, press to manually go up (▲) or down (▼) the radio frequency. In menu mode, use to select various settings.



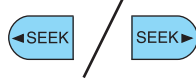
In Satellite Radio mode (if equipped), press ▲ / ▼ to enter TEXT MODE and scroll through the current song title, artist, channel category and Sirius Long Channel Name .

1. **▲ / ▼ Tune/Disc selector:** In radio mode, press to manually go up (▲) or down (▼) the radio frequency.



In menu mode, use to select various settings.
In CD mode, press to select the desired disc.

In Satellite Radio mode (if equipped), press ▲ / ▼ to enter TEXT MODE and scroll through the current song title, artist, channel category and SIRIUS Long Channel Name. *Not available on some models.*
In TEXT MODE, occasionally, the display text requires additional text to be displayed. When the ">" indicator is active press the SEEK > to view the additional display text. When the "<" indicator is active press the < SEEK to view to the previous display text.

In CATEGORY MODE, press ▲ / ▼ to scroll through the list of available Sirius channel Categories (Pop, Rock, News, etc.). Refer to *Category Mode* under *Menu* for further information.

Occupancy mode: (Available on Audiophile radios only): Press MENU repeatedly to access. Press ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to optimize sound for ALL SEATS, DRIVERS SEAT or REAR SEATS.

CLOCK (Setting the clock): Press until SELECT HOUR or SELECT MINS is displayed. Press ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to adjust the hours/minutes.

Track/Folder Mode: Available only on MP3 discs in CD mode. In Track Mode, pressing ◀ SEEK ▶ will scroll through all tracks on the disc. In Folder mode, pressing ◀ SEEK ▶ will scroll only through tracks within the selected folder.

Compression: Available only in CD mode, compression brings soft and loud CD passages together for a more consistent listening level.

Repeat (Not available on some models.): In CD mode, press to repeat the current CD track.

RDS (Available on Audiophile radios only): RDS is available in FM mode, and allows you to search RDS-equipped stations for a certain category of music format: Classic, Country, Info, Jazz/RB, Religious, Rock, Soft, Top 40. RDS must be activated to access Find and Show functions.

To activate, press and hold MENU until RDS (ON/OFF) appears in the display. Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to toggle RDS ON/OFF. When RDS is on, press MENU repeatedly to scroll through Find, Show and RDS. When RDS is Off, you will not be able to access Find and Show functions.

Find: RDS must be activated to access the Find function. Find allows you to search RDS-equipped stations for the desired music category.

Use ▲ / ▼ to find the desired program type, then use ◀ SEEK ▶ or SCAN to begin the search.

Show: RDS must be activated to access the Show function. Show allows you to display the name of the radio station or program type.

Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to show type, name or none.

RBDS (Radio Broadcast Data System) (Available on Audiophile audios only): RBDS is available in FM mode, and allows you to search RBDS-equipped stations for a certain category of music format: Classic, Country, Info., Jazz/RB, Religious, Rock, Soft, Top 40. RBDS must be activated to access Find and Show functions. *(Not available on some models.)*

To activate: Press MENU until RBDS (ON/OFF) appears in the display.

Use ▲ / ▼ / ◀ SEEK ▶ to toggle RBDS ON/OFF. When RBDS is ON, press MENU to get to the category display. When RBDS is OFF, you will not be able to access the Find function.

Find: RBDS must be activated to access the Find function. Find allows you to search RBDS-equipped stations for the desired music category.

Use ▲ / ▼ to find the desired program type, then use ◀ SEEK ▶ to begin the search.

Show: RBDS must be activated to access the Show function. Show allows you to display the name of the radio station or program type. Use TEXT/SCAN to show type, name or none.

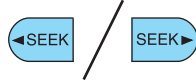
4. **Aux:** Press repeatedly to cycle through FES/DVD (if equipped), SAT1, SAT2 and SAT3 modes (Satellite Radio if equipped). If no auxiliary sources are available, NO AUX AUDIO will be displayed.

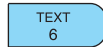

17. **LOAD:** Press to load a CD. Press LOAD and a memory preset to load to a specific slot. Press and hold to autoloop up to six CDs.



18. **CD eject:** Press to eject a CD. Press and hold to auto eject all CDs present in the system. If there is no CD present, the display will read NO CD.



19. **CD slot:** Insert a CD label side up.



GENERAL AUDIO INFORMATION

Radio frequencies: AM and FM frequencies are established by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and the Canadian Radio and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC). Those frequencies are:

AM - 530, 540–1700, 1710 kHz

FM- 87.7, 87.9–107.7, 107.9 MHz

Radio reception factors: There are three factors that can affect radio reception:

- Distance/strength: The further you travel from a station, the weaker the signal and the weaker the reception.

- Terrain: Hills, mountains, tall buildings, power lines, electric fences, traffic lights and thunderstorms can interfere with your reception.
- Station overload: When you pass a broadcast tower, a stronger signal may overtake a weaker one and play while the weak station frequency is displayed.

Cassette/player care:

Do:

- Use only cassettes that are 90 minutes long or less.
- Tighten very loose tapes by inserting a finger or pencil into the hole and turning the hub.
- Remove loose labels before inserting tapes.
- Allow tapes which have been subjected to extreme heat, humidity or cold to reach a moderate temperature before playing.
- Clean the cassette player head with a cassette cleaning cartridge after 10–12 hours of play to maintain good sound/operation.

Don't:

- Expose tapes to direct sunlight, extreme humidity, heat or cold.
- Leave tapes in the cassette player for a long time when not being played.

CD/CD player care:

Do:

- Handle discs by their edges only. Never touch the playing surface.
- Inspect discs before playing. Clean only with an approved CD cleaner and wipe from the center out.

Don't:

- Expose discs to direct sunlight or heat sources for extended periods of time.
- Clean using a circular motion.

CD units are designed to play commercially pressed 4.75 in (12 cm) audio compact discs only. Due to technical incompatibility, certain recordable and re-recordable compact discs may not function correctly when used in Ford CD players. Dirty, warped or damaged CDs, irregular shaped CDs, CDs with a scratch protection film attached, and CDs with homemade paper (adhesive) labels should not be inserted into the CD player. The

label may peel and cause the CD to become jammed. It is recommended that homemade CDs be identified with permanent felt tip marker rather than adhesive labels. Ballpoint pens may damage CDs. Please contact your authorized dealer for further information.

Audio system warranty and service: Refer to the *Warranty Guide* for audio system warranty information. If service is necessary, see your dealer or qualified technician.

Satellite radio information (if equipped)

Satellite radio channels: Satellite radio frequencies are established by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). SIRIUS Satellite Radio broadcasts within a frequency range of 2320.0 MHz-2332.5 MHz. This frequency range is sub-divided into over 120 channels of music, news, sports, weather and traffic programming. For a complete set of SIRIUS Satellite Radio channels, visit www.sirius.com or call SIRIUS at 1.888.539.7474. For a quick reference of the SIRIUS Satellite Radio channel guide, refer to the *Sirius Welcome Kit*.

Satellite radio reception factors: To receive the satellite signal, your vehicle has been equipped with a satellite radio antenna located on the roof of your vehicle. The vehicle roof provides the best location for an unobstructed, open view of the sky, a requirement of a satellite radio system. Like AM/FM, there are several factors that can affect satellite radio reception performance:

- **Antenna Obstructions:** For optimal reception performance, keep the antenna clear of snow and ice build-up and keep luggage and other material as far away from the antenna as possible.
- **Terrain:** Hills, mountains, tall buildings, bridges, tunnels, freeway overpasses, parking garages, dense tree foliage and thunderstorms can interfere with your reception.
- **Station overload:** When you pass a ground based broadcast repeating tower, a stronger signal may overtake a weaker one and result in an audio mute.

Unlike AM/FM audible static, you will hear an audio mute when there is a satellite radio signal interference. Your radio display may display NO SIGNAL to indicate the interference.

SIRIUS satellite radio service: SIRIUS Satellite Radio is a continental U.S. based satellite radio service that broadcasts over 120 channels of music, sports, news and entertainment coast-to-coast. A service fee is required in order to receive SIRIUS service. Vehicles that are equipped with a factory installed SIRIUS Satellite Radio system include:
