Removal and Installation

- 1. Disconnect the battery ground cable. For additional information, refer to Section 414-01.
- 2. Disconnect the ignition coil electrical connectors.

- 3. Remove the ignition coil bolts.
 - To install, tighten to 5 Nm (44 lb-in).
- 4. **NOTE:** When removing the ignition coils, a slight twisting motion will break the seal and ease removal.

Remove the ignition coils.

- 5. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
 - Apply a light film of silicone brake caliper grease and dielectric compound to the inside of the coil boots before installation.
