FAQ's

Q: When is Track Day?

A: Track Day will be held on **Saturday, November 17, 2012 from 9am-5pm**. Here is the itinerary for the day:

- The MANDATORY driver's meeting and track instructions from ECR Staff at 8:30am-9am. All drivers MUST attend this meeting. Please arrive early enough to prepare your car for the track if doing any "self-prepping" to your car.
- Track goes hot shortly after driver's meeting. This depends on how long the meeting lasts; normally about 30 minutes for instructions/Q&A.
- Lunch 1130am-1230pm
- Back on the track from 1230p-5pm.
*We may stay until 4pm depending on temperatures that day.

Q: Where do I register for Track Day?

A: Anyone that wants to participate can contact Corey White to reserve a slot. You may also stop by Five Star Ford of Plano to register. Please include the following:

1. First and last name
2. Direct contact phone number and email address
3. Emergency phone number and contact name
4. Year, make, and model of car you plan to drive
5. Level of track experience. (Cars will be broken up into groups based on driver's experience)

Q: Who can register?

A: You must be at least 18 years old to participate.

Q: Where is Eagles Canyon Raceway?

A: About 1 hr north of the DFW area. Visit their website: <http://www.eaglescanyon.com/2008/home.php> for more information and directions.

Q: What kinds of cars can enter?

A: All cars are welcome! I'm sure we would all like to watch Mustangs, Corvettes, Camaros, BMWs, and Porsches chasing one another around the track!. Remember this is NOT a race.

Q: How much is the registration fee for Track Day?

A: There is a \$170 admission fee to enjoy a full day at the track. Five Star Ford of Plano will also be providing lunch for attendees, staff, and other guests. Spectators are more than welcome to come out and watch, of course at no charge.

Q: What is needed to ensure that my car is ready for the track?

A: To ensure that car is ready to hit the track safely you should perform a Car Safety Inspection.

If you are unclear what items need to be inspected prior to putting your car on the track, please contact me, Corey White for an inspection list or go to: http://www.eaglescanyon.com/docs/ECR_CarSafetyInspection.pdf and download the required form and take it to your local dealership's service department. This form MUST be signed by an inspector before you will be able to put your car on the track.

Q: What are some suggestions you have for preparing my car for the track?

A: In addition to the items on the mandatory Car Safety Inspection Checklist, it's recommend that Boss owners review page 36 and 37 of Boss Owner's Supplemental manual "Track Use Preparation". If you need a copy of these pages, please email me and I'll send you these two pages.

Q: Can Five Star Ford prepare my car?

A: YES, Five Star Ford of Plano can prepare your car! Here are some special track preparation service prices:

- Front brake pad swap and rotor resurfacing for \$150.00 plus the cost of parts per axle.
- Car Safety Inspection, as seen on ECR's website: \$49.95
- Fluid Flush: \$49.95
- Call for even more services, all done by Ford Certified technicians

Our attendance goal is 40 cars to meet track requirements. However, if we get 50, that's even better!!
