
REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

Removal and Installation

- 1. Drain the engine cooling system. For additional information, refer to Cooling System Draining, Filling and Bleeding in this section.
- 2. Disconnect the battery ground cable. For additional information, refer to Section 414-01.
- 3. Disconnect the block heater electrical connector and position aside.
- 4. CAUTION: Do not loosen the block heater retaining screw more than necessary for removal.

Loosen the block heater retaining screw and remove the block heater.

- To install, tighten to 2 Nm (18 lb-in).
- 5. To install, reverse the removal procedure.
 - Lubricate the block heater seal and the cylinder block hole with clean engine coolant to ease installation.
 - Make sure the block heater electrical connector is routed and secured away from rotating or hot components or damage to the cable can occur.
- 6. Fill and bleed the cooling system. For additional information, refer to Cooling System Draining, Filling and Bleeding in this section.
